

Graduation Requirements (Information Technology Program)

The FCIT offers a Bachelor degree in Information Technology. Students must complete 139 credits (according to Bi-Semesters "two semesters" Study Plan) to be awarded a Bachelor's degree. Table 1 illustrates graduation requirements for the Bachelor degree in Information Technology.

A student graduates after successfully completing the graduation requirements according to the degree plan, as long as his cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) and major GPA are both not less than 2.00 out of 5.00. Following the recommendation of the Department Council, the Faculty Council, or its authorized representative may determine certain additional courses the student must take to improve his cumulative GPA if he has passed the required courses, but with a low GPA. It should be noted that the student's graduation status is only conferred upon approval by the University Council.
