The following are the results obtained from a questionnaire analysis.

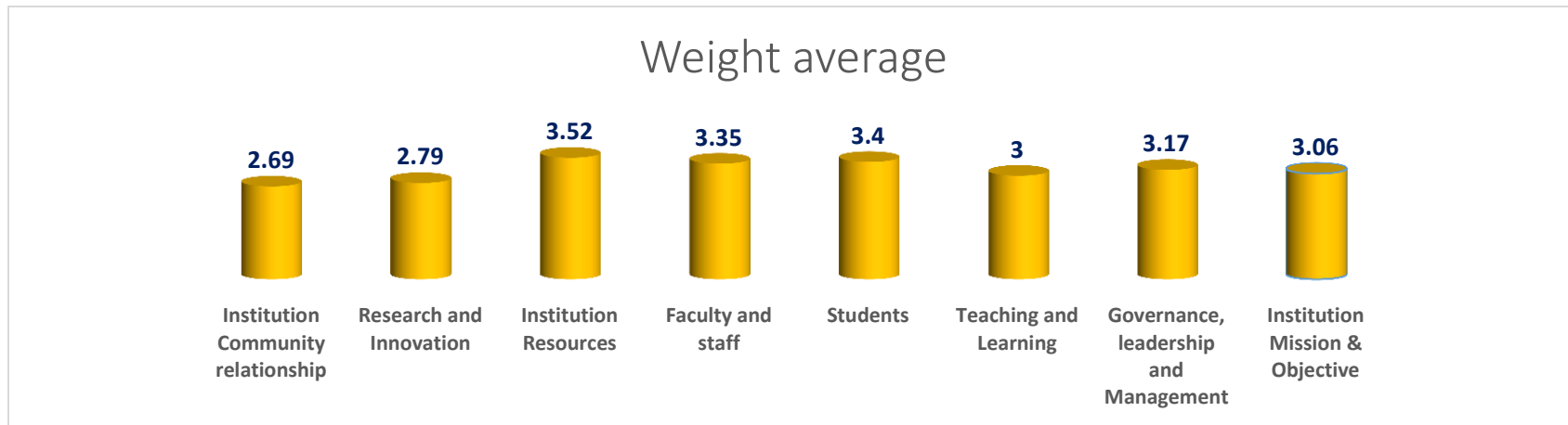

Analysis:

From the above table, we notice the average of the phrase whose average is less than 3 represents weaknesses points mentioned below:

- ✓ The second standard (governance, leadership and management), the institution takes the graduates feedback regarding university future plans equal 2.45
- ✓ Also standard 6: Computer labs are up to date and appropriate for students, with an average of less than three (2.47)
- ✓ standard 7: Research and Innovation (Faculty involved me in their research activities) with an average of less than three (2.57).
- ✓ standard 8: Institution community relationship (The community services provided by the institution is satisfactory) with an average of less than three (2.52)

Generally, overall average weight was 68.6%
