

Where we note the level of satisfaction is less than 50%, except for phrase 9 and 11. In general, the satisfaction rates are considered low compared to the generally accepted satisfaction rates. I recommend the department's management to work on improving library services.

Recommendations:

- 2. Math program should insure that its curriculum satisfies the needs of the labor market.
