Educating students with disabilities has been developing rapidly in recent times, and there is a noticeable interest in providing the necessary support to students with disabilities at all stages of education. The issue of educating and rehabilitating people with disabilities represents a cultural challenge to nations and societies. Because it is primarily a humanitarian issue that hinders the progress of nations, given that people with disabilities represent no less than (10%) of the total population at the local and international levels, and these large numbers of people with disabilities constitute an educational loss that threatens the national and global economy, and according to some announced statistics, The number of disabled people in the world is (600) million people, more than (80%) of whom are in developing countries. No matter how different the statistics are and how conflicting the numbers are, the biggest problem is the small number of people who receive services and care, as those who receive the services required in this field They represent only 9.1% of people with disabilities. The Disabilities Unit at the Deanship of Student Affairs at the University of Tabuk seeks to provide all services and assistance to students with disabilities, which include guidance and counseling, and identifying the problems they face, in order to provide services and devices that guarantee them an appropriate social and educational environment. In addition to providing and implementing accredited programs to educate people with disabilities, which include psychological and social preparation programs in addition to introducing them to the available programs that suit their disability to choose from. And work to integrate them into the educational and community environment and participate in curricular and extracurricular activities by facilitating access to educational courses in a way that ensures their academic progress. The unit also provides all technical services by providing the necessary equipment for the educational process by providing special laboratories for people with visual and hearing disabilities and others. The unit also contributes to facilitating the process of obtaining financial support for them by submitting to comprehensive rehabilitation and obtaining approval to disburse their financial reward.

Objectives

The unit aims to be a model for caring for students with disabilities at the level of the Tabuk region, represented by the following strategic objectives: 1- Laying the modern foundations for caring for students with disabilities at the University of Tabuk. 2- Providing an integrated counseling and educational service in one place, which saves the student a lot of effort and time in implementing academic programs to develop their interactive, social and academic skills. 3- Create a comprehensive database that is subject to continuous updating for students with disabilities at the main headquarters and branches. 4- Appointing representatives from colleges and branches regarding students with disabilities. 5- Conduct advanced research in the field of supporting students with disabilities. 6- Contributing to the training of those working with students with disabilities, and raising their efficiency through the assistance of specialized experts. 7- Holding seminars and forums aimed at enhancing the

personal, cognitive and skill growth of students and specialists. 8- Building partnerships with entities providing direct and indirect support for the benefit of students with disabilities.

His Excellency the Director of University of Tabuk, Prof. Abdullah bin Mufarrah Al-Dhaibi, inaugurated the unit for caring for people with disabilities in the presence of the university's vice president, Dr. Atiyya Al-Daifai, the director of the Comprehensive Rehabilitation Center in Tabuk, Asad Abu Hashem, a member of the Tabuk Club for People with Special Needs, Sultan Al-Anzi, and a number of college deans and department heads.

The university director explained that the unit was established to serve students with disabilities, and the opening of the unit for the female section will take place in the near future. The unit provides a

range of services benefiting both male and female students at University of Tabuk, as well as individuals with disabilities from the local community.

Dr. Fahad Al-Masoudi, the general supervisor of the unit, highlighted that the unit includes training rooms, activity rooms, and a specialized laboratory equipped with assistive technology. It features the latest assistive technologies for students with disabilities, including computers equipped with "SuperNova" software, which assists blind and visually impaired individuals in using computers easily.

He added that the lab includes devices such as portable and desktop magnifiers, a text-to-speech reader that reads documents in Arabic and translates texts from English to Arabic. Additionally, it includes a Braille Sense Polaris device (electronic notepad) that helps blind individuals navigate smartphone screens and personal computers, equipped with electronic map systems, allowing blind individuals to communicate with the world through social media platforms.
